

## About MD Consult:

**MDConsult** provides electronic access to FIRSTConsult, full-text subspecialty books, clinical journals, practice guidelines, and drug information. Special content includes: Customized care instructions that patients can take home after an office visit or hospital stay and CME.

A **simple intuitive search interface** is provided to locate information from any or all of MDConsult's content area. These content areas include:

- **FIRSTConsult:** an evidence-based online product designed to help in clinical decision-making at the point of care, can be searched from within MD Consult. Click on the search result and be taken to the appropriate location within the FIRSTConsult content.
- **Leading Medical Reference Books:** Search the entire collection simultaneously. Also, search, locate and compare over 50,000 high-quality images.
- **Full-Text Journals and Clinics of North America:** Search for full text articles from the 80+ journals, including many of the "Clinics of North America" journals
- **Journal Database:** Simultaneously search the full text of MDConsult's online journals and millions of MEDLINE abstracts.
- **Guidelines:** A collection of more than 1,000 peer-reviewed practice guidelines, which are organized by topic and authoring organization for easy browsing.
- **Patient Education:** Nearly 10,000 printable, patient handouts which can be customized, adding your own notes, patient instructions, and contact information.
- **CME:** Grand Rounds activities across 15 specialties. FREE CME credit for the first five conferences, plus Clinical Cornerstone and FREE CME, sponsored by Exerpta Medica.
- **Drug Information:** MD Consult drug information provided by Gold Standard.

The MDConsult **Personal Account** is available. The Personal Account allows use of a folder area, customization of patient handouts, and other specialized features. To use the Personal Account click on MDConsult's "Create Account" feature in the upper right corner.

**Access Note:** To create an MDConsult **Personal Account** you must be connected directly to a computer on the University of Pittsburgh or UPMC networks. Once this account is created you may connect to MDConsult's Personal Edition through HSLS Remote Access.

**Access to HSLS Resources** (databases, e-journals, and e-books) is restricted by legal contracts to current faculty, staff, and students of the University of Pittsburgh or UPMC only.

HSLs Resources are available from any computer connected to the Pitt or UPMC computer networks, which includes most Pitt and UPMC locations.
